RCACF scholarships available to students

The Russell County Area Community Foundation, RCACF, has scholarship money available to area high school seniors and college students.

Scholarships are available through seven different funds at the foundation.

The Adolph Bohler Student Aid Fund is available to any Russell High School student attending accredited post-secondary institutions.

The Doran and Bina Dole Scholarship is two, \$2,500 scholarships, one

renewable for 4 years. The scholarships are available for RHS students attending accented post-secondary schools, with preference to those students with documented disabilities.

The Joshua Scholarship is for RHS graduates up to 30 years old attending accredited post-secondary institutions.

The Murphy Memorial Scholarship is available to high school seniors in the Gorham Telephone Company's service area attending accredited post-secondary institutions.

The David Ochs Memorial scholarship is made available to any RHS students attending accredited post-second-

ary institutions.

The Pohlman Family Scholarship is for high school seniors of Unified School District 407 or USD 399 attending accredited post-secondary institutions.

The Paul E. Ruggels Memorial Scholarship is for students who have graduated from RHS or Natoma High School who have completed their first academic year of post-secondary education.
